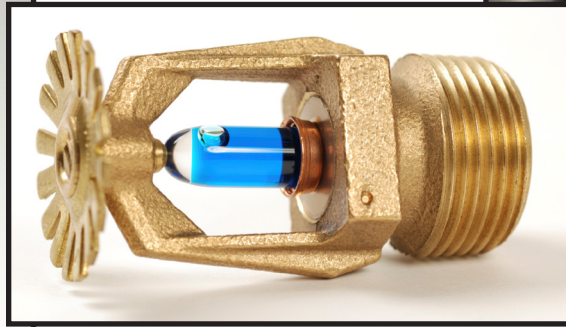


BUILDING A TEAM OF LEADERS
